Christian Sweet's life has been anything but sweet. As a young man born and raised in South Dallas, Christian was faced with the same four bad choices that all Black youth in the hood are faced with: bang, slang, pimp, or hustle. Christian chose the fifth alternative which was a boring life.

A BORING LIFE

While most were in the streets, Christian 'stayed out the way' and chose gaming as his outlet. Though he dropped out of high school and caught a charge, he continued on the boring route.

And while often perceived as lonely and lame, the boring life proved to be the safest.

As opposed to taking penitentiary chances and jeopardizing his life, he chose the boring way of freedom and learned how to legally navigate the hood and avoid its many pitfalls.

And thus the Boring Movement began.

THE BORING MOVEMENT

The Boring Movement started as a t-shirt design in 2020. The t-shirts were designed with hood youth in mind because so often the hood doesn't teach youth an alternate route to success.

The goal of the movement is to provide a fashionable roadmap to safety and freedom while inspiring youth to go after their hood dreams. Christian does this by incorporating his experiences as a Black millenial faced with traveling the boring route...alone.

Christian masterfully shares his experiences of...

being a high school dropout, dealing with the criminal justice system, growing up with a parent with mental illness, surviving his mother's house being shot up, moving over 30 times, homelessness, heartbreak, and much, much more.

Christian is also the co-owner of **Sweet Tees**, where he incorporates his passion for gaming into fashion. He is also the co-contributor to, 'The Do-It-Yourself Guide out of Homelessness', a compelling guide that helps young Black homeless men take ownership of their ugly past by teaching them how to convert their knock hood skills and experiences into money-making soft business skills.
